A scaled score of 100 is expected standard. A scaled score of 110 or more is the threshold for a pupil's performance to be viewed as being to a higher standard than expected.

Progress

*The calculating of 'Value Added' nationally ensures that average progress is zero

This is calculated using a value added measure from KS1 to KS2. It is based on value added in each of reading, writing and maths compared with the scores of pupils with the same Key Stage 1 results.

Progress scores will be centred around 0, with most schools within the range of -5 to +5.

- A score of 0 means pupils in this school on average do about as well at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A positive score means pupils in this school on average do better at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
- A negative score means pupils in this school on average do worse at KS2 as those with similar prior attainment nationally.

A negative score does not mean that pupils did not make progress, rather it means they made less progress than other pupils nationally with similar starting points.
